Updated Visitation

Policy & Procedure

Policy: To safely reduce some restrictions implemented previously on visitation due to the Covid '19 Pandemic, while adhering to updated guidance and mitigating any risk of resurgence.

Procedure:

- As per the latest CMS and DOH guidance regarding visitation, all residents can have visitors at all times without restrictions, while adhering to the core principles of infection prevention. The only visitors that will be restricted are anyone who is COVID positive, symptomatic, or in quarantine. Screening upon entry to the facility will continue for all guests.

- Indoor visitation is allowed for all residents and there is no maximum of visitors or scheduling in advance needed. Scheduling can be encouraged to allow for best compliance with the core principles such as Hand hygiene (use of alcohol-based hand rub is preferred), Face covering or mask (covering mouth and nose) and physical distancing at least six feet in between people, in accordance with CDC guidance
- While not recommended, even residents on precautions or quarantine can have visitation in their rooms and wearing face masks.
- Visits are also allowed during an outbreak and visitors will be informed so they understand the risks of visiting during that time and encouraged to wear appropriate PPE.
- Visitors will not be required to test or disclose vaccination status but if they do not disclose their status, they should wear a face mask at all times.
- Instructional signage posted in the facility and proper education on COVID-19 signs and symptoms, infection control precautions
- Cleaning and disinfecting high frequency touched surfaces in the facility often, and designated visitation areas after each visit.
